Prof. Varyam Singh

Eminent poet and translator and Russian scholar. He has 5 books and more than 15 collections of translation from Russian, Belarusian,

Ossetian and Kyrgyz poetry. He is also a recipient of Soviet Land Nehru Award, Himachal Academy of Arts, Culture and Languages Award, Ramchandra Shukla Award among others to his credit.

Ms. Paramita Satpathy

She is an influential voice in Odia Literature. She has 9 published books to her credit in Odia, English and Hindi. Her works have been widely translated into different Indian languages. She is the recipient of Odisha Sahitya Academy Award, Bhartiya Bhasha Parishad Award, Sea Shore Srujan Award and few other.

Prof. Radhavallabh Tripathi

One of the senior-most professors of Sanskrit in the country. Prof. Tripathi has published many books, research papers and critical essays as well as translations of more than 30 Sanskrit plays and some classics from Sanskrit into Hindi. He has widely acclaimed for his original contributions to the study of Nāṭyaśāstra and Sāhityaśāstra and received 33 national and international awards and honors for his literary contributions.

Sri Vikram Sampath

He is a well-known English writer. He is the author of three highly acclaimed books of non-fiction and history, which have been translated into other Indian languages. He has founded the prestigious Bangalore Literature Festival and Bangalore International Folk Festival. He has been honored with ARSC International Award, recipient of Sahitya Academy's Yuva Puraskar, visiting fellowship at Wissenschaftskolleg in Berlin and University of Queensland, Australia. Presently he is serving as the Executive Director of the Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts (IGNCA), Regional Centre, Bangalore.

Dr. K. Sreenivasarao

He holds Master's and Doctorate Degrees in English Literature and has been closely involved with various national level literary and cultural institutions for over a decade now. He has translated a Children's dictionary from English to Telugu. He is the recipient of Delhi Telugu Academy Award for 2011.
